In the same sentence someone may say, *"I love my spouse and I love chocolate."* The latter is not a true use of the word if we really look at what God says about love. In John 15:12-13, we read, *"This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that he lay*

*down his life for his friends.” How will you show true sacrificial love today?*
