# Dream India Mission Trip

December 13-23, 2018  
or January 3-13, 2019

Anyone who has an interest in traveling to India on behalf of GoServe Global, please contact Sheila Willms, visit with her personally or contact her via the email address below. The team is arranging travel plans for either December 13-23 or January 3-13. The work that is currently being done in India supports the efforts of Pastor Sunny Raul in Orissa State, located in the eastern part of the country. Sunny and his wife, Kuni, operate Emmanuel School which serves nearly 100 children from poor area villages and neighborhoods. Additionally, Sunny conducts outreaches to tribal villages, sharing the gospel and supporting local pastors.

The trip being planned will include a variety of activities. Last year, we began in the capital city and distributed backpacks filled with supplies to impoverished children of the Untouchable caste. Then we traveled by train to Emmanuel School where we enjoyed playing and getting to know the children, did painting projects, and participated in teacher training workshops for the purpose of program development. One day, we got to travel to one of the remote tribal villages where we participated in a worship service with the people there. Each trip is a little different, but would likely include many of these same elements.

**Accommodations:** When in the capital city, we typically stay a night or two in a hotel. While not fancy by US standards, each room has its own bathroom. When at Emmanuel School, we stay on the school compound

in rooms designed for guests. They are quite comfortable and also have their own bathrooms with shower.

**Food:** We eat well! Our hosts are sensitive to dietary restrictions and conservative American pallets, and make adjustments for us. Rice and vegetables are most common, although we were indulged with a range of proteins, sweets, etc. We always drink bottled water and it's unusual for anyone to become ill.

**Cost:** The costs for the trip will be in the following range \$2,700-\$3,000 which includes flights, food and lodging; it does not include the cost of a passport, visa or personal expenditures.
